

Tourism Minister meets Governor; discuss Shri Amarnathji Yatra arrangements

JAMMU, APRIL 16 – Mr. Nawang Rigzin Jora, Minister for Tourism and Culture, called on Mr. N. N. Vohra, Governor, at Raj Bhavan here today.

During their meeting, Mr. Jora briefed the Governor about the various initiatives being taken by the Tourism Department for the promotion of tourism in the State, including the projected schemes for developing a pilgrim tourism circuit in Jammu, a Sufi circuit in Kashmir Valley and a Buddhist circuit in Ladakh.

They also discussed the arrangements to be made for the ensuing Yatra to the Holy Cave Shrine of Shri Amarnathji, particularly those which relate to the Department of Tourism. Among other matters, the timely commissioning of the shelter sheds/toilets at the various identified locations along the Yatra routes, by the Tourism Department, and increasing their number, wherever required, also came up for discussion.
