

## SHRI AMARNATHJI YATRA 2022

### Procedure for providing Registration to ex-India Pilgrims

To Register for Shri Amarnathji Yatra 2022, an ex-India pilgrim shall need to send scanned copies of the following documents to Shri Rohit Raina, Chief Manager, IT, Department, Punjab National Bank, Circle Office, Jammu, at the email address: [cojkitd@pnb.co.in](mailto:cojkitd@pnb.co.in) contact no. 09906062025.

1. A new Registration Yatra Permit Form shall be issued to the Yatris who had registered themselves for Yatra 2021 and had not taken back refund amount through Ex-India Pilgrim Registration. These Yatris shall upload the previous secured Yatra Permit Form issued for Yatra 2021 with a fresh Compulsory Health Certificate and Registration Application Form and then apply for a fresh Yatra Permit Form for Yatra 2022. The fee already paid during Yatra 2021 shall be mutually adjusted by the concerned Bank when the Registration opens for Yatra 2022.
2. Yatris who had registered for Yatra 2021 and have crossed the age of 70 years will not be allowed to undertake Yatra 2022. They can surrender/upload the original Permit and can take refund amount back from the Board when the Registration opens for Yatra 2022.

  - d) **Registration of Rs 1520/- (rupees fifteen hundred and twenty) per Yatri** (to be deposited in the Punjab National Bank: Swift Code: PUNBINBBJTS, Account Number 0794000101212056)
3. Compulsory Health Certificate should have been issued by National Health Services of the country concerned after 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
  4. The intending pilgrim will have the choice of collecting the Yatra Permit from the designated branch of Punjab National Bank located at Jammu or Srinagar. This choice shall be indicated by the pilgrim in her/ his forwarding e-mail.

5. Registration of ex-India Pilgrims shall be subject to availability of Registration quota for the preferred day and route.
6. Shri Rohit Raina, Chief Manager, IT Department, Punjab National Bank, Circle Office, Jammu will inform the Pilgrim via e-mail, whether she / he has been Registered for the Yatra and the location of Bank Branch at Jammu/ Srinagar from where the Yatri would be required to collect the Yatra Permit.
